


INSTRUCTIONS


Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.


Make one 12" SEAL PUP quilt block.


















Seal Pup PILLOW TUTORIAL








Pillow Top should measure 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

PILLOW ASSEMBLY

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric 9 rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap 5 ½". Pin the backing in place and machine baste ½" from the edge.



FINISHING

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method. The finished pillow measures 18 ½" x 18 ½"
