MATERIALS AND CUTTING

	7" x 15"	(2) 2 ½" x 3"	1
		(1) 2 ½" x 12 ½"	2
	9" x 18"	(1) 2 ½" x 12 ½"	3
		(2) 2 ½" x 16"	4
Pillow Backing	1 FQ	(2) 11 ½" × 16 ½"	5
Backing Fabric	1 FQ	18" x 18"	
Batting		18" x 18"	
Binding	1/4 yard	(2) 2 1/4" x WOF	

INSTRUCTIONS


Finished pillow size: 16 1/2" x 16 1/2"

Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.


Make one 12" MRS. SANTA CLAUS quilt block.

















Pillow Top should measure 16 1/2" x 16 1/2"

PILLOW ASSEMBLY

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric E rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap 4 ½". Pin the backing in place and machine baste ½" from the edge.



FINISHING

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method.

PILLOW ASSEMBLY

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric E rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure $\frac{11}{2}$ " x $\frac{16}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap 4 ½". Pin the backing in place and machine baste ½" from the edge.



FINISHING

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method.
