Instructions

- Read all instructions before you begin.
- Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.
- I recommend starching your fabric, as it will make cutting and sewing easier, especially when working with small pieces.
- WOF means width of fabric (yardage is based on 42" wide fabric), FQ means Fat Quarter, FE means Fat Eighth.

The fabric choices for the Country Garden quilt blocks might differ from the fabric choices in the single quilt block patterns. For fabric placement please refer to the quilt layout on page 7.






Mini Quilt Assembly

Make each two 6" Tulip and Fence quilt blocks and each one 6" Mole, Waterig Can, Fork & Trowel, Standing Bunny and Butterfly quilt block (the patterns are available in my Etsy Shop: https://www.etsy.com/de/shop/ellisandhiggs).

Follow the steps below to assemble the Country Garden mini quilt. Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by








Assemble the quilt blocks and sashing strips into three rows as shown above.

The rows should measure 6 ½" x 20 ½".





Assemble the rows and sashing strips as shown above. The finished quilt top should measure 20 ½" x 24 ½".


Finishing

Make a quilt sandwich with your quilt top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired.

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the quilt using your favorite binding method.




Quilt Assembly


Make (11) 12" Tulip quilt blocks, (5) 12" Fence quilt blocks and each one 12" Honey Bee, Mole, Fork & Trowel, Watering Can, Standing Bunny, Rainboot, Wheelbarrow, Butterfly and Hen quilt block.


Follow the steps below to assemble the Country Garden quilt. Use a 1/4" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.



















3 Assemble the quilt blocks and sashing strips into five rows as shown below. The rows should measure 12 ½" x 66 ½".



Sew Fabric 2 strips end to end. Subcut (5) 2 ½" x 66 ½" strips. Sew Fabric 4 strips end to end. Subcut (5) 2" x 66 ½" strips. Assemble the rows and sashing strips as shown below. The finished quilt top should measure 66 ½" x 77 ½".



Finishing

Sew together the backing pieces. Make a quilt sandwich with your quilt top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired.
